(Session 2024-2026)

Time-line

1. Online Registration	09 th -19 th August 2024
2. Submission of hard copy of the application form	16 th - 21 th August 2024 (Till 4:00 pm)
3. Entrance Test	25 th August 2024 (Sunday)
4. Result Declaration	09 th September 2024.
5. Admission	10 th to 13 th September 2024
6. Commencement of Session	16 th September 2024

1. Eligibility Criteria

Minimum Educational Qualification should be Graduate/Post-graduate (B.A./B.Com./B.Sc.) from a college/university recognized by UGC.

- a. Minimum 50% marks (for General category)
- b. Minimum 47% marks (for OBC category)
- c. Minimum 45% marks (for SC/ST category)
- d. In-service Candidates (should be working as Primary, Graduate or Post Graduate teachers on regular basis in Govt. schools of the state)

(Candidate must have studied school teaching subject at the Graduation/PostGraduation level. Candidate with vocational subject/IT /other technical courses will not be eligible for admission to B.Ed. Course)

2. Seat Intake

I. In-service candidates	- 10
II. Differently abled candidates	- 05
III. Non-COI candidates	- 10
IV. COI holding candidates	- <u>125</u>

Total: 150

(In case of unfilled seats by the candidates in any of the above category, his/her seat will be allotted to next candidate on merit list)

3. Examination Fee

An examination fee of Rs. 700/- is required to be paid at the time of hard-copy submission of application at college office. Payment will be accepted through online payment service. Payment by any other mode will not be accepted. The examination fee once paid will NOT be refunded. The fee can be paid by online/bank transfer to the college account mentioned below.

4. Scheme of Examination

- a. Test Pattern: Objective type with multiple choice questions
- b. Time Limit: 2 hours
- c. Total Marks: 100
- d. Syllabus
 - I. General English (25 marks)
 - II. General Knowledge/Current affairs (25 marks)
 - III. Domain Subjects (Science, Social Science & Mathematics) (20 marks)
 - IV. Teaching Aptitude (30 marks)

5. Selection Procedure

- a. Selection/ admission will be made purely on merit basis.
- b. Merit list will be prepared category-wise, as per marks obtained in the entrance exam.
- c. If two or more applicants have same marks in the entrance test, preference will be given to the applicant with higher educational qualification.
- d. If two or more applicants have same marks in the entrance test with same educational qualification then preference will be given to the applicant with higher percentage of marks in that degree (educational qualification).
- e. If any selected candidate does not take admission within stipulated time, then admission will be given to the candidate next-in-line, as per merit list.

6. Documents Requirement

Application Form in original with one set of self-attested photocopy of the following documents (originals of these must be produced for verification at the time of admission)

- I. Marks-sheet & Certificates of Graduation & onwards
- II. COI for local candidates
- III. Certificate of being differently abled with minimum 40% disability from Social Welfare Department, Government of Sikkim (for PWD category)
- IV. No Objection Certificate from Education Department (for In-service category)
- V. Category Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC)
- VI. Latest passport sized photographs (2 nos.)
- VII. Hard copy of Payment receipt/ transaction ID
